👉 As developer: Get involved early

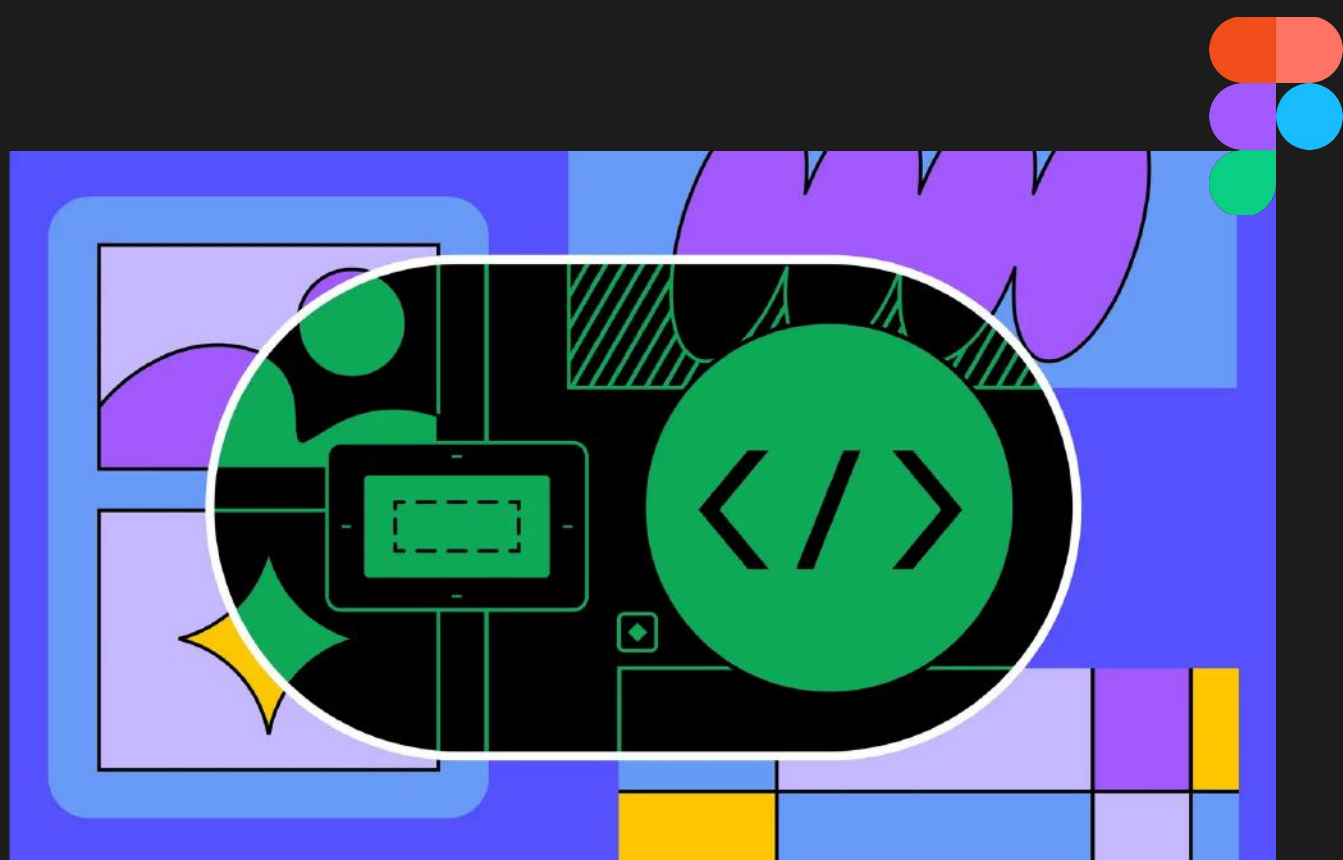
🤔 It's not Hand-off and Done. It's an ongoing communication process **on the same level**.

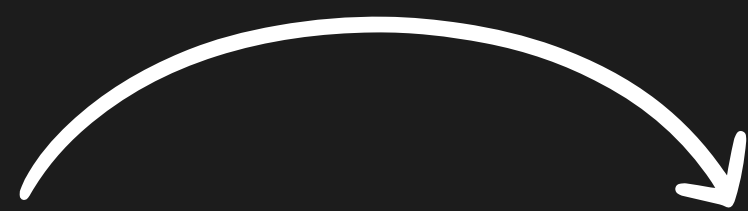
